2 The Company is mainly engaged in the business of Manufacturing of Plastic bottles, Jars and Caps. Hence, there is no separate reportable segment as per Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 108 on 'Operating Segment'.

3 Effective 1st April, 2018, the Company has adopted Ind AS 115 " Revenue Form Contracts with Customers". The application of Ind AS 115 did not have any material impact on the financial results of the Company.

4 The company has purchased the business of its subsidiary M/s Juniper Polymer Industries LLP on October 01st 2018. The accounting has been done as per Appendix C of Ind AS 103 "Business Combination Under Common Control" and the excess consideration paid over Net Assets acquired has been trasnferred to capital reserve.

5 Ministry of Corporate Affairs has notified new Accounting Standard 116 Lease which will be implemented from April 01st 2019. The company is evaluating the requirement of this standard and its effect on the Financial Statements of the company.

6 Provision for current tax and deffered tax has been recognised by the company at Year end after considering deduction under Section 80IE as unit of the company is situated in exempted zone, as benefits can only be calculated at year end.

7 Previous quarter's amount have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary to conform to the current quarter's presentation.
